Beginning at point at edge of sea bluff which is the North angle of the land of Makaoku, marked by a galvanized spike, from which the Government Survey Trig. Station "Mokuola" bears North $54^{\circ} 51'$ West true, distant 750.7 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 4534.0 feet North and 10222.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2537, and running by true bearings:-

1. S. $37^{\circ} 15'$ E. 197.0 feet along the land of Makaoku to spike;
2. S. $50^{\circ} 45'$ E. 270.0 feet along same to spike;
3. S. $51^{\circ} 32'$ E. 39.5 feet along same to spike at South angle;
4. N. $60^{\circ} 58'$ E. 69.85 feet to spike at East angle;
5. N. $51^{\circ} 32'$ W. 516.8 feet along Lot 2 to a + marked on solid rock on sea bluff, thence following along sea bluff to point of beginning, the direct bearing and distance being:
6. S. $78^{\circ} 30'$ W. 15.7 feet to said point of beginning.

AREA 60/100 ACRE, more or less.

Excepting and reserving therefrom the public road across this lot, as shown on plan attached hereto and made a part hereof.
