Beginning at the Northwest corner of this lot, at a post, at "Kahawai" Trig. Station on top of Southeast edge of Kahawai Crater, the coordinates of which point are 12898.0 feet South and 19449.3 feet West of "Kapoho" Trig. Station, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2071, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 226° 57' 400.0 feet along Keahialaka to the edge of Puulena Crater;
2. 319° 58' 178.5 feet along South edge of crater;
3. 308° 11' 137.7 feet along South edge of crater;
4. 291° 18' 200.0 feet along South edge of crater;
5. 255° 22' 173.4 feet along South edge of crater;
6. 239° 06' 200.0 feet along South edge of crater;
7. 225° 46' 243.0 feet along South edge of crater;
8. 270° 00' 388.4 feet along Keahialaka;
9. 53° 46' 1390.0 feet along Grant 1535, Ap. 1;
10. 136° 57' 706.0 feet along Lot 2 to the point of beginning.
