

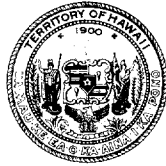

Beginning at a spike in concrete at the East corner of this lot, being also the West corner of Akala Road (30 feet wide) and Kaumana Road (50 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaumana" being 744.81 feet North and 793.64 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2923, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from true South:-

1. Along the Northwest side of Kaumana Road on a curve to the left having a radius of 275.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being:  
45° 36' 18" 169.54 feet to a spike in concrete;
2. 145° 39' 30" 97.42 feet along Government land to a spike;
3. 235° 39' 30" 164.74 feet along Grant 4538 to A. Mac Aulton (Lot 22-A, Ponahawai Homesteads) to a spike;
4. 323° 48' 67.82 feet along the Southwest side of Akala Road to the point of beginning.
