

Beginning at a concrete post on a canoe-shaped crack in lava at Waaomai, on the ancient trail roadway between Kaohē and Keonepoko-iki, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "PUAAKOKOKE" being 3455.90 feet South and 780.40 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Homestead Map 21, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 340° 34' 126.00 feet along road along Kaohē and Waiakahiula boundary;
2. 340° 20' 462.00 feet along road along Kaohē and Waiakahiula boundary;
3. 348° 34' 383.00 feet along road along Kaohē and Waiakahiula boundary;
4. 347° 38' 383.00 feet along road along Kaohē and Waiakahiula boundary;
5. 45° 18' 1576.00 feet along Lot 1-A;
6. 155° 02' 1171.00 feet along Lot 2-B to the west angle of Lot 1-B;
7. 224° 05' 593.00 feet along ancient foot path;
8. 222° 37' 537.00 feet along ancient foot path;
9. 222° 10' 718.00 feet along ancient foot path to the point of beginning.
