Beginning at a concrete post on a canoe-shaped crack in lava at Waaomai, on the ancient trail roadway between Kaohe and Keonepokoiki, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puaakokoke" being 3455.9 feet South and 780.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Homestead Map No. 21, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 42° 10' 718.0 feet along ancient foot path;
2. 42° 37' 537.0 feet along ancient foot path;
3. 44° 05' 593.0 feet along ancient foot path to the West angle of Lot 1B;
4. 335° 02' 1171.0 feet along Lot 2 to the South angle of Lot 1B;
5. 225° 18' 1576.0 feet along Lot 1A;
6. 167° 38' 383.0 feet along road along Kaohe and Waiakahiula boundary;
7. 168° 34' 383.0 feet along road along Kaohe and Waiakahiula boundary;
8. 160° 20' 462.0 feet along road along Kaohe and Waiakahiula boundary;
9. 160° 34' 126.0 feet along road along Kaohe and Waiakahiula boundary to the point of beginning.
