Resurvey--May 1956

Pouhala, Waikele, Ewa, Oahu, T. H.

Being portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Pouhala.

Beginning at a pipe at the southeast corner of this parcel of land and at the northwest corner of a 15 foot Roadway and Pouhala Homestead Road (30.00 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "EWA CHURCH" being 3646.38 feet South and 10495.28 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 4084, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 87° 17' 155.27 feet along the north side of Pouhala Homestead Road (30 feet wide) to a pipe;
2. 177° 17' 132.77 feet along Waipahu Library Site to a pipe;
3. 156° 15' 81.68 feet along L.C.Aw. 858, Apana 2 to Kanealoha to a pipe;
4. 258° 42' 169.35 feet along the south side of Farrington Highway (F.A.G.H. 4-C and F.A.P. 4-C) to a pipe;
5. 355° 21' 20.71 feet along jog in the south side of Farrington Highway (F.A.G.H. and F.A.P. 4-C) and along Land Court Application 1538 to a pipe;
6. 352° 53' 214.21 feet along Land Court Application 1538 and along the west side of a 15 foot Roadway to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 0.781 Acre.

Vehicle access into and from Farrington Highway (F.A.G.H. 4-C and F.A.P. 4-C) shall not be permitted over and across Courses 4 and 5 of the hereinabove described Lot 1, Part 1.
