
Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 501, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 9527.6 feet South and 10110.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 85° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 1, Block 501, to an iron pipe;
2. 175° 40' 180.0 feet along East side of Volcano Road to an iron pipe;
3. 265° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 3, Block 501, to an iron pipe;
4. 355° 40' 180.0 feet along Lot 12, Block 501, to the point of beginning.

AREA 1 ACRE.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 11/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 89/100 ACRE.
