Beginning at a spike and pile of stones at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 1 and on the North side of the Volcano Road, from which point the true azimuth and distance to a pipe at the South corner of Lot 1 is $50^{\circ} 08'$ 325.66 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kulani" are 34116.8 feet South and 21115.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2411, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $149^{\circ} 31'$ 781.5 feet along Lot 1 to a post;
2. $239^{\circ} 31'$ 170.7 feet along Lot 9 to a post;
3. $329^{\circ} 31'$ 753.3 feet along Lot 2B to a post;
4. $50^{\circ} 08'$ 173.0 feet along Volcano Road to the point of beginning.
