Being a portion of Lot 8, Grant 6174 to William Henry,
of the Keaahala Homesteads, Kaneohe, Oahu.

Beginning at a 3/4" galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this piece, on the west side of a 20 foot road, the same being the South-east corner of Lot 1, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "COOLIDGE" being 869.1 feet South and 1846.6 feet West, and running by true azimuths from the above described initial point:-

1. Thence curving to the left with a radius of 98 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 299° 56' 30" 95.3 feet to a pipe.
2. Thence curving to the right with a radius of 80 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 278° 46' 22 feet to a pipe;
3. 34° 13' 444.6 feet along Lot 3 to a pipe;
4. 114° 38' 232.7 feet to a pipe;
5. 228° 00' 480.6 feet along Lot 1 to the point of beginning, and containing an area of 75,698 square feet.
