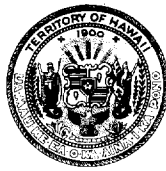

Being portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Waiakea

Beginning at the southeast corner of this lot, the southwest corner of Grant 9814 to En Leong Wung, Trustee for Hilo Chinese Christian Church, and on the north side of Mohouli Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "Halai" being 2006.62 feet South and 5056.06 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2600, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 59° 00' 764.23 feet along the north side of Mohouli Street;
2. 149° 00' 851.73 feet along Lot 1, Waiakea Cane Lots;
3. 239° 00' 1018.87 feet along Lot 1-A, Waiakea Cane Lots;
4. 328° 10' 678.75 feet along government land;
5. 58° 10' 267.00 feet along Grant 9814 to En Leong Wung, Trustee for Hilo Chinese Christian Church;
6. 328° 10' 169.20 feet along same to the point of beginning.
