Beginning at a post at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 3 and on the North side of the Volcano Road, from which point the true azimuth and distance to a pipe at the South corner of Lot 1 is $50^{\circ} 08'$ 678.36 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kulani" are 33890.8 feet South and 21386.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2411, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $50^{\circ} 08'$ 179.7 feet along Volcano Road to a post;
2. $149^{\circ} 31'$ 753.3 feet along Lot 2A to a post;
3. $239^{\circ} 31'$ 177.3 feet along Lot 9 to a post;
4. $329^{\circ} 31'$ 724.0 feet along Lot 3 to the point of beginning.
