Beginning at an iron pipe at the North corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 4, Block 403, on the West side of "Road 1 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" 7461.4 feet South and 9041.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along the West side of "Road 1 West", on a curve to the right having a radius of 651.8 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: $335^{\circ} 02' 30''$ 156.1 feet to an iron pipe;
2. $71^{\circ} 55'$ 242.0 feet along Lot 2, Block 403, to an iron pin;
3. $155^{\circ} 02' 30''$ 98.1 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
4. $238^{\circ} 10'$ 242.0 feet along Lot 4, Block 403, to the point of beginning.
