Beginning at a post at the South corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 2B, on the North side of the Volcano Road, from which point the true azimuth and distance to a pipe at the South corner of Lot 1 is $50^{\circ} 08'$ 678.36 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kulani" are 33890.8 feet South and 21386.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2411, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $149^{\circ} 31'$ 724.0 feet along Lot 2B to a post;
2. $239^{\circ} 31'$ 308.3 feet along Lots 8B and 8A to a post;
3. $329^{\circ} 31'$ 673.0 feet along Lot 4B to a post at the North side of the Volcano Road;
4. $50^{\circ} 08'$ 312.48 feet along the Volcano Road to the point of beginning.
