Beginning at a post at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 15 and on the South side of Kilauea Road, from which point the true azimuth and distance from a pipe at the North corner of Lot 6 is $59^{\circ} 31'$ 323.3 feet, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kulani" being 32014.0 feet South and 21756.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2411, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $239^{\circ} 31'$ 154.15 feet along Kilauea Road to a post;
2. $329^{\circ} 31'$ 1544.4 feet along Lot 4 to a post at the North side of Volcano Road;
3. Along the Volcano Road on a curve to the right with a radius of 766.0 feet to a post, the direct azimuth and distance being $59^{\circ} 30'$ ~~154.2~~ feet;
59-40-30 154.15
4. $149^{\circ} 31'$ 1544.9 feet along Lots 2 and 15 to the point of beginning.
