Beginning at the Northwest corner of Kaukonahua Government Remainder Lot 2 and station 5 of same, also the West corner of Grant 1333 to Kealohi, from which the "Maile" Trig. Station bears S 32° 23' W 4982 feet distant, thence by true bearings:-

1. S 9° 45' W 1005 feet along the West boundary of Kaukonahua Government Remainder Lot 2 to the North bank of the Kaukonahua Stream;
2. N 42° 15' W 985 feet along the North bank of the Kaukonahua Stream and Grant 856 to Kekio to the North bank of said Kaukonahua Stream;
3. Thence in a Northwesterly direction along the said bank of said stream to its intersection with the prolongation of the West boundary line of Grant 1330 to Kuahiwilau, the direct bearing and distance being N 58° 40' W (true) 513 feet;
4. N 9° 45' E 654 feet along the East boundary of Kaukonahua Government Remainder Lot 5 to the West corner of Grant 1330 to Kuahiwilau;
5. S 61° 10' E 1328 feet along the South boundary of Grant 1330 to Kuahiwilau to the point of beginning.
