WAIAHOLE HOMESTEADS.

Koolaupoko, Oahu.

Lot No. 3.

Beginning at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of L.C.A. 7650:2, Kaiwi, marked by a red wood post and from which point Government Survey Trig. Station Kuolele bears S 52° 55' W and Kuolani bears S 41° 8' W true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2196, and running by true bearings:-

1. S 15° 12' W 389.4 feet along Lot No. 2 to ridge, thence the boundary is the watershed of the ridge, direct bearings and distances being:
 2. S 19° 49' E 446.2 feet along Lot No. 2 to a stake;
 3. S 58° 55' E 1156.3 feet along Lot No. 2 to a stake on peak;
 4. S 10° 8' W 276.2 feet along Kaalaea to a stake;
 5. S 58° 23' W 959.2 feet along Kaalaea to a stake at saddle of ridge;
 6. N 76° 29' W 1328.9 feet along Kaalaea to peak on ridge from which Government Trig. Stations Kiolea bears N 73° 29' 30" E and Makikiki bears N 25° 28' W true;
 7. N 32° 59' E 915.2 feet along Lot No. 4 to end of ridge;
 8. N 15° 43' E 1123.7 feet along Lot No. 4 to a red wood post at the Southeast corner of L.C.A. 10230:1, Maikaalooa;

- 9. N 7° 29' E 10.0 feet along L.C.A. 10230:1, Ma~~ka~~kaaloa, to a red wood post at the Southwest corner of L.C.A. 7660:1, Kekuinae;
- 10. N 83° 57' E 191.0 feet along L.C.A. 7660:1, Kekuinae, to a red wood post at the Southeast corner of L.C.A. 7660:1, Kekuinae;
- 11. S 80° 6' E 127.5 feet along L.C.A. 7650:2, Kaiwi, to the initial point.

Containing an area of 47.48 acres.

Reserving a 30 foot right of way for the Government road.
