Beginning at a spike in concrete at the North corner of this lot, on the West boundary of L.C.Award 4983 to Kukeleau and on the South side of Kaumana Road (50 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaumana" being 766.83 feet North and 1018.32 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2923, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from true South:-

1. 345° 46' 53.60 feet along L.C.Award 4983 to Kukeleau to a concrete monument;
2. 333° 30' 147.90 feet along same to a spike;
3. 72° 28' 86.62 feet along Government land to a spike;
4. 162° 28' 199.60 feet along Lot 4, Ponahawai House Lots to a spike;
5. 252° 28' 66.50 feet along the South side of Kaumana Road to the point of beginning.
