WAIHAOLE HOMESTEADS.

Koolaupoko, Oahu.

Lot No. 4.

Beginning at a peak known as Kuaiani, whose coordinates from Government Trig. Station Puu Kauai are 4138.4 feet W. and 472.4 feet S. and from which Makikiki bears N 41° 31' 30" W true and Kiolea bears N 77° 19' 15" E true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2196, and running by true bearings:-

1. N 30° 13' E 953.1 feet down the ridge along Lot No. 5 to a stake;
2. N 25° 5' W 717.1 feet along Lot No. 5 to a redwood post at the South corner of L.C.A. 10231:1, Mahina,;
3. N 8° 20' W 66.0 feet along L.C.A. 10231:1, Mahina, to a redwood post;
4. N 38° 45' E 330.0 feet along L.C.A. 10231:1, Mahina, to a redwood post on the South bank of Waiahole Stream;
5. Thence along the Waiahole Stream to a redwood post on the South bank and a corner of L.C.A. 7649:1, Kalei, the direct bearing and distance being: N 56° 46' E 577.0 feet;
6. S 15° 33' W 141.9 feet along L.C.A. 7649, Kalei, to a redwood post;
7. S 12° 57' W 194.0 feet along L.C.A. 7649:1, Kalei;
8. N 86° 44' E 379.5 feet along L.C.A. 7649:1, Kalei, to a redwood post;

- 9. S 80° 34' E 103.4 feet along L.C.A. 10231:1, Maikaaloo, to a redwood post;
- 10: S 15° 43' W 1123.7 feet along Lot No. 3 to a stake;
- 11. S 32° 59' W 915.2 feet along Lot No. 3 up ridge to a peak, the watershed of the ridge is the boundary;
- 12. N 82° 29' 30" W 454.8 feet along Kaalaea to the initial point.

Reserving a 30 foot right of way for Government road.
