Lot 4.

Beginning at a $\frac{1}{2}$ on stone and ahu on the mauka line of the Government Road, the coordinates of which are 513.6 feet North and 9254.5 feet East of Trig. Station Paheehē, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2165, and running by true bearings:-

1. N 82° 15' E ¹⁰⁸⁶⁰ ~~10835~~ feet along Lot 3 to a $\frac{1}{2}$ on a stone and ahu;
2. S 15° 23' E 1366 feet along Forest Reserve to a $\frac{1}{2}$ on stone and ahu at edge of small bluff;
3. S 00 27' W 987 feet along Forest Reserve to a $\frac{1}{2}$ on stone and ahu;
4. S 82° 9' W ¹⁰⁷⁹⁹ ~~10780~~ feet along Lot 5 to a $\frac{1}{2}$ on stone and ahu at the Government Road;
5. N 8° 00' W 800 feet along mauka line of Government Road;
6. N 11° 25' W 1550 feet along mauka line of Government Road to initial point.
