LOT 4. BEING A PORTION OF THE GOVERNMENT LAND

OF WAHIAWA: WAIALUA: OAHU. H.I.

Commencing at the south corner of this Lot on the east side of the Kaukonahua gulch at a place called Pakarū, adjoining Waiahae-uka, and running :-

1. N. $23^{\circ} 17'$ W. true 1612. feet along Lot 1.B. to a red-wood post on the south edge of avenue (80. Feet wide); Thence-
2. N. $66^{\circ} 43'$ E. true 2315. feet along avenue and across dry gulch to a red-wood post; From this post the government Survey station Kokoloea bears S. $57^{\circ} 40'$ W. true;
3. N. $51^{\circ} 58'$ E. true 400. feet along road to a red-wood post;
4. S. $23^{\circ} 17'$ E. true 1740. feet along Lot 5.A. Thence -
5. S. $67^{\circ} 1'$ W. ,, 2700. ,, ,, Waiahae-uka to initial point.
