Beginning at a post at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 4B and on the North side of Volcano Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kulani" being 33592.4 feet South and 21747.0 feet East as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2411, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 149° 31' 650.0 feet along Lot 4B to a post;
2. 239° 31' 154.15 feet along Lot 7A to a post;
3. 329° 31' 649.6 feet along Lot 5 to a post on the North side of Volcano Road;
4. Along Volcano Road on a curve to the left with a radius of 537.7 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 59° 23' 154.2 feet to the point of beginning.
