Beginning at a post at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 4A and on the North side of Volcano Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kulani" being 33592.4 feet South and 21747.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2411, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along the Volcano Road on a curve to the left with a radius of 537.7 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being  $55^{\circ} 08' 26.9$  feet;
2.  $50^{\circ} 08'$  129.0 feet along Volcano Road to a post;
3.  $149^{\circ} 31'$  673.0 feet along Lot 3 to a post;
4.  $239^{\circ} 31'$  154.15 feet along Lot 7B to a post;
5.  $329^{\circ} 31'$  650.0 feet along Lot 4A to the point of beginning.
