Beginning at stone marked with the letter "H" and being the Southeast corner of Grant 846 to Haapou, from which the "Maile" Trig. Station bears S 9° 37' W (true) 5260 feet distant, and "Puu Pane" bears S 46° 17' W (true) 10248 feet distant, thence by true bearings:-

1. S 61° 10' E 706 feet to the Southwest corner of Grant 1330 to Kuahiwilau;
2. S 9° 45' W 654 feet along the West boundary of Kaukonahua Government Remainder Lot 3 to the North bank of the Kaukonahua Stream;
3. N 73° 45' W 666 feet along the North bank of the Kaukonahua Stream and the North boundary of Grant 859 to Hopemanu to its intersection with the prolongation of the East boundary line of Grant 846 to Haapou;
4. N 9° 45' E 800 feet along the East boundary of the Kaukonahua Government Remainder Lot 8 to the point of beginning.

Area 11.07 acres, more or less.
