Beginning at a spike set in concrete at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 7, and on the North side of road (30-feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaneahuea" being 1701.0 feet North and 875.8 feet East as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2813, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 187° 40' 125.8 feet along Lot 7 to a spike set in concrete;
2. 273° 32' 80.0 feet along L.C.A. 8531 Ap. 1 to Kalua to a spike set in concrete;
3. 00° 58' 47.1 feet along Grant 5599 to M. K. Makekau to a spike in old cross on set stone;
4. 7° 40' 84.8 feet along Lot 3 to a spike set in concrete;
5. 97° 40' 85.3 feet along road (30-feet wide) to the point of beginning.
