Kaohē Homestead Lots,  
Puna, Hawaii.

Beginning at the North corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 4 (Grant 5017 to Mrs. Sarah B. Henry), on the boundary between Kaohē and Keonepoko Iki, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puaakoko" being 6889.0 feet South and 5332.0 feet West, approximately, as shown on Government Survey Homestead Map No. 21, and running by true azimuths:

1. 33° 42' 506.0 feet along ancient foot path along Kaohē-Keonepoko Iki boundary;
2. 40° 41' 670.0 feet along ancient foot path along Kaohē-Keonepoko Nui boundary;
3. 338° 15' 1640.0 feet along Mauka Road along land of Kaaha;
4. 239° 51' 1190.0 feet along Lot 5A;
5. 153° 38' 2070.0 feet along Lot 4, (Grant 5017 to Mrs. Sarah B. Henry) to the point of beginning.
