
Beginning at an iron pipe at the East corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 5, Block 303, on the West side of "Road 1 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 5745.3 feet South and 7976.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 58° 10' 242.0 feet along Lot 5, Block 303, to an iron pipe;
2. 148° 10' 180.0 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
3. 238° 10' 242.0 feet along Lot 7, Block 303, to an iron pipe;
4. 328° 10' 180.0 feet along the West side of "Road 1 West" to the point of beginning.

AREA 1 ACRE.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 07/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 93/100 ACRE.

and 7896.1 feet East, as shown on G.S.
Reg. Map N^o 2600, and running by
true angle.
