Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot, at a post and mound of stones on the North boundary of Keahialaka, the coordinates of which point are 4359.1 feet South and 34013.6 feet West of "Kapoho" Trig. Station, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2071, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $274^{\circ} 20'$  436.0 feet along Keahialaka;
2.  $196^{\circ} 25'$  1377.0 feet along Lot 7;
3.  $106^{\circ} 30'$  161.0 feet along School Lot;
4.  $196^{\circ} 30'$  369.0 feet along School Lot to road;
5.  $106^{\circ} 30'$  885.0 feet along South edge of 50 foot road;
6.  $357^{\circ} 50'$  1938.0 feet along Lots 5, 4, 3 and 2 to the point of beginning.
