Beginning at a spike at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 7, Ponahawai House Lots, and on the South side of Kaumana Road (50 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaumana" being 693.69 feet North and 804.05 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2923, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from true South:-

1. Along the South side of Kaumana Road, on a curve to the right, having a radius of 225.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: 246° 18' 10" 48.34 feet to a spike in concrete;
2. 252° 28' 47.00 feet along same to a spike;
3. 342° 28' 199.60 feet along Lot 5, Ponahawai House Lots, to a spike;
4. 72° 28' 83.60 feet along Government land to a spike in concrete;
5. 159° 06' 194.77 feet along Lots 8 and 7, Ponahawai House Lots, to the point of beginning and passing over a spike at 82.70 feet.
