Beginning at a galvanized iron spike and ahu at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 5, on the East side of Manono Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai", being 2943.0 feet South and 9141.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2566, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 270° 00' 225.0 feet along Lot 5 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
2. 360° 00' 100.0 feet along Lot 8 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. 90° 00' 225.0 feet along Lot 9 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. 180° 00' 100.0 feet along the East side of Manono Avenue to the point of beginning.
