Being a portion of Lot 8, Grant 6174 to William Henry,  
of the Keaahala Homesteads, Kaneohe, Oahu.

Beginning at a 3/4" galvanized iron pipe at the South corner of this piece, on the North-east side of a 20 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "COOLIDGE", being 979.0 feet South and 1624.3 feet West, and running by true azimuths from the above described initial point:

1. 127° 46' 100 feet along the North-east side of the 20 foot road to a pipe;
2. Thence curving to the left with a radius of 100 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 109° 19' 63.3 feet to a pipe;
3. Thence curving to the right with a radius of 78 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 163° 28' 30" 148.9 feet to a pipe;
4. 236° 05' 288.5 feet along the South side of a 20 foot road to a pipe;
5. 8° 35' 390.4 feet along Lot 8 to the point of beginning, and containing the area of 54,424 square feet.
