Beginning at the South corner of this lot and on the Northeast side of the Koolau Railway Right-of-way (40 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "South Base" being 1032.4 feet South and 53.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2000, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 143° 42' 50.5 feet along the Northeast side of Koolau Railway Right-of-way;
2. 170° 05' 28.5 feet along L.C.A. 10972 & 10975 to Waiiaua;
3. 261° 15' 161.0 feet along same;
4. 18° 50' 60.0 feet along L.C.A. 8313 Apana 2, to Kamoiliili;
5. 42° 10' 28.0 feet along same;
6. 79° 40' 87.5 feet along L.C.A. 8418 to Kamaka, to the point of beginning.
