Beginning at a galvanized iron spike and ahu at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 6, on the West side of Mililani Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai", being 2943.0 feet South and 8651.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2566, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $360^{\circ} 00'$ 100.0 feet along the West side of Mililani Avenue to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
2. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 200.0 feet along Lot 10 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. $180^{\circ} 00'$ 100.0 feet along Lot 7 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 200.0 feet along Lot 6 to the point of beginning.
