Beginning at a pipe in concrete at the Southeast corner of this lot, on the North boundary of Grant 7203 to Kaunaholu, and on the Northwest side of a proposed 40-Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Keokea 2" being 332.75 feet South and 228.85 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2814, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 86° 11' 155.43 feet along Grant 7203 to Kaunaholu and along Government Reserve to a pipe in concrete, passing over an iron pin in concrete at 110.73 feet;
2. 176° 11' 68.00 feet along Government Reserve to a pipe in concrete;
3. 266° 11' 157.00 feet along Lot 9, to a pipe in concrete;
4. 309° 07' 33" 42.17 feet along Government Reserve to a pipe in concrete;
5. Thence along the Northwest side of a proposed 40-Foot Road on a curve to the left with a radius of 430.28 feet to the point of beginning, the direct azimuth and distance being 35° 43' 57" 50.94 feet.
