Beginning at a post at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 10 and on the North side of Keonelehua Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kulani" being 30072.7 feet South and 22298.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2411, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $59^{\circ} 31'$  200.0 feet along Keonelehua Avenue to a post;
2.  $149^{\circ} 31'$  653.4 feet along Lot 8 to a post;
3.  $239^{\circ} 31'$  200.0 feet along Lot 14 to a post;
4.  $329^{\circ} 31'$  653.4 feet along Lot 10 to the point of beginning.
