Being portion of Lot 8, Keaahala Homesteads, being portion of Grant 6174 to William Henry, situate in Keaahala, Kaneohe, Koolaupoko, Oahu, and more particularly described as follows:

Lot 9-A, Keaahala Springs Tract.

Beginning at a 3/4 inch pipe on the southwest corner of this piece and on the east side of a 20 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Coolidge" being 1098.0 feet South and 1490.9 feet west and running by true azimuths:-

1. On a curve to the left with a radius of 100 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being  
142° 08' 49.6 feet;
2. 127° 46' 55.10 feet along the east side of a 20 foot road;
3. 236° 05' 239.4 feet;
4. 22° 27' 33.90 feet;
5. 10° 00' 149.30 feet;
6. 1° 30' 5.40 feet;
7. 75° 06' 88.70 feet to the point of beginning and containing an area of 18530 square feet.
