Being a portion of the Government Land of Kaniahiku

Beginning at the southeast corner of this lot, the north-east corner of Lot 2, Block 3, Kaniahiku Village Site, and on the west side of the 50-Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "HONUULA" being 2144.13 feet North and 12428.91 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map H.S.S. Plat 819, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 92° 31' 180.80 feet along Lot 2, Block 3, Kaniahiku Village Site;
2. 182° 31' 121.54 feet along Lot 4-A, Block 3, Kaniahiku Village Site;
3. 272° 31' 150.80 feet along the south side of the 50-Foot Road;
4. Thence along the southwesterly side of the 50-Foot Road, on a curve to the right with a radius of 30.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being 317° 31' 42.43 feet;
5. 2° 31' 91.54 feet along the west side of the 50-Foot Road to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 0.50 Acre.
