Being a portion of the Government Land of Kaniahiku

Beginning at the southwest corner of this lot, the northwest corner of Lot 2, Block 4, Kaniahiku Village Site, and on the east side of the 50-Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "HONUULA" being 2101.93 feet North and 12380.71 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map H.S.S. Plat 819, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 182° 31' 131.57 feet along the east side of the 50-Foot Road;
2. Thence along the southeasterly side of the 50-Foot Road, on a curve to the right with a radius of 30.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being 227° 31' 42.43 feet;
3. 272° 31' 240.80 feet along the south side of the 50-Foot Road;
4. 2° 31' 161.57 feet along Nanawale Forest Reserve, Part 3 (Executive Order 1666);
5. 92° 31' 270.80 feet along Lot 2, Block 4, Kaniahiku Village Site, to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 1.00 Acre.
