Beginning at a galvanized iron spike and ahu at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 12, on the West side of Mililani Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai", being 3143.0 feet South and 8651.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2566, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 90° 00' 200.0 feet along Lot 12 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
2. 180° 00' 100.0 feet along Lot 9 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. 270° 00' 200.0 feet along Lot 8 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. 360° 00' 100.0 feet along the West side of Mililani Avenue to the point of beginning.
