Beginning at a pipe in concrete at the East corner of this lot, the West corner of the intersection of Piikea Street (40 feet wide) and Wailuku Drive (50 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 445.10 feet North and 8588.72 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2658, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 50° 14' 165.95 feet along the Northwest side of Wailuku Drive to a pipe;
2. 140° 14' 187.66 feet along Lot 101 to a pipe;
3. 250° 44' 30" 214.01 feet along government land to a pipe in concrete;
4. 337° 15' 117.85 feet along the West side of Piikea Street to the point of beginning.
