Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 1001-B and on the Northwest side of "Road A", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 18200.3 feet South and 101.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 58° 57' 240.1 feet along the Northwest side of "Road A" to an iron pipe;
2. 61° 08' 390.8 feet along same to a stake;
3. 151° 08' 113.2 feet along camp site No. 6-A to a stake;
4. 96° 14' 285.8 feet along same to a stake;
5. 85° 40' 77.4 feet along same to an iron pipe;
6. 175° 40' 1051.2 feet along Lot 1003 to an iron pipe;
7. 265° 40' 975.5 feet along Lot 915 to an iron pipe;
8. 355° 40' 936.2 feet along Lot 1001-B to the point of beginning.
