Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, and the Northeast corner of "Road A" and "Road 6 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 18505.8 feet South and 2967.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 1024.7 feet along the East side of "Road 6 West" to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 938.0 feet along Lot 917 to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 1110.2 feet along Lot 1003 to an iron pipe;
4. 85° 40' 99.1 feet along camp site No. 6-B to a stake;
5. 355° 40' 36.7 feet along same to a stake;
6. 106° 48' 90.9 feet along the North side of "Road A" to an iron pipe;
7. 94° 32' 572.0 feet along same to an iron pipe;
8. 89° 02' 100.8 feet along same to an iron pipe;
9. 82° 37' 30" 88.6 feet along same to the point of beginning.
