Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 1008 and on the North side of "Road A", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 19481.7 feet South and 5833.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 1783.5 feet along Lot 1008 to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 968.0 feet along Lot 920 to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 1537.9 feet along Lot 1006 to an iron pipe;
4. 62° 02' 30" 476.2 feet along the North side of "Road A" to an iron pipe;
5. 75° 32' 138.9 feet along same to an iron pipe;
6. 81° 18' 30" 396.1 feet along same to the point of beginning.
