Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 1007 and on the North side of "Road A", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 19481.7 feet South and 5833.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $81^{\circ} 18' 30''$ 204.4 feet along the North side of "Road A" to an iron pipe;
2. $81^{\circ} 36' 30''$ 732.4 feet along same to an iron pipe;
3. $161^{\circ} 31'$ 10.2 feet along same to a stake;
4. $61^{\circ} 27'$ 491.0 feet along same to a stake;
5. $332^{\circ} 51'$ 10.0 feet along same to an iron pipe;
6. $64^{\circ} 14'$ 109.8 feet along same to an iron pipe;
7. $175^{\circ} 40'$ 1201.8 feet along Lot 1009 and government land to an iron pin;
8. $265^{\circ} 40'$ 1482.8 feet along government land to a spike in pahoehoe;
9. $355^{\circ} 40'$ 893.5 feet along Lot 1007 to the point of beginning.
