

Beginning at a red wood post at the South corner of this lot and the intersection of the Mokolea and Kainalu Roads, the coordinates of said red wood post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Mokapu" being: 20926.4 feet South and 1472.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2502, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 125° 39' 90.0 feet along the North side of Kainalu Road to a stake;
2. 222° 52' 235.33 feet along Lot 9 to a stake;
3. 312° 57' 200.1 feet along Lot 11 to a stake;
4. 51° 25' 45.05 feet along Molokea Road to a red wood post;
5. 73° 03' 206.8 feet along Mokolea Road to the point of beginning.
