Beginning at a spike set in concrete at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 13, and on the South side of road (30 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaneahuea" being 1687.6 feet North and 672.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2813, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 262° 07' 38.9 feet along road (30 feet wide), to a spike set in concrete;
2. 277° 40' 48.0 feet along same to a spike set in concrete;
3. 346° 37' 84.6 feet along Lot 8, to a spike set in concrete;
4. 78° 12' 93.5 feet along Government Land to a spike set in concrete;
5. 172° 07' 103.5 feet along Lot 13, to the point of beginning.
