Station "Hakuma" being 7587.4 feet North and 5028.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2700, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 196° 04' 140.00 feet along East side of a road reservation to an iron spike;
2. 286° 04' 692.16 feet along Lot 103 to an iron spike;
3. 335° 12' 185.12 feet along Government land to an iron spike;
4. 106° 04' 813.28 feet along Lot 105 to the point of beginning.
