Beginning at an iron pipe at the East corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 12, Block 302, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 5285.7 feet South and 8034.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 58° 10' 242.0 feet along Lot 12, Block 302, to an iron pipe;
2. 148° 10' 180.0 feet along the East side of "Road 1 West" to an iron pipe;
3. 238° 10' 242.0 feet along Lot 10, Block 302, to an iron pipe;
4. 328° 10' 180.0 feet along Lot 8, Block 302, to the point of beginning.

AREA 1 ACRE.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 09/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 91/100 ACRE.
