Beginning at an iron pipe at the North corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 1001-A and on the South-east side of "Road A", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 18256.1 feet South and 97.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 1407.8 feet along Lots 1001-A and 1101 to an iron pipe;
2. 85° 40' 935.5 feet along Lot 1202 to an iron pipe;
3. 175° 40' 948.6 feet along the East side of "Road 5 West" to an iron pipe;
4. 249° 29' 16.6 feet along the Southeast side of "Road A" to an iron pipe;
5. 235° 07' 221.2 feet along same to an iron pipe;
6. 241° 08' 587.3 feet along same to an iron pipe;
7. 238° 57' 218.2 feet along same to the point of beginning.
