*Government Reservation*

Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 1209-B, and on the East side of "Road 8 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 2173.0 feet South and 8822.7 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $175^{\circ} 40'$  881.7 feet along the East side of "Road 8 West" to an iron pipe;
2.  $282^{\circ} 31'$  180.0 feet along the South side of "Road A" to a stake;
3.  $288^{\circ} 40'$  212.7 feet along same to a stake;
4.  $272^{\circ} 01'$  133.6 feet along same to a stake;
5.  $265^{\circ} 51'$  429.9 feet along same to a stake;
6.  $249^{\circ} 36'$  104.4 feet along same to a stake;
7.  $233^{\circ} 45'$  532.2 feet along same to a stake;
8.  $244^{\circ} 14'$  154.9 feet along same to a stake;
9.  $355^{\circ} 40'$  1096.9 feet along Lot 1108 to an iron pipe;
10.  $85^{\circ} 40'$  1627.1 feet along Lot 1209-B to the point of beginning.

AREA  $30\text{-}98/100$  ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of  $55/100$  Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF  $30\text{-}43/100$  ACRES.
