Beginning at an iron spike at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 110, on the East side of a road reservation, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Hakuma" being 6828.3 feet North and 4809.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2700, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 286° 04' 743.82 feet along Lot 110 to an iron spike;
2. 52° 00' 153.01 feet along Grant 7126 to H.P. Morton and across 50 foot road to a  cut on Pahoehoe;
3. 72° 30' 47.23 feet along Grant 7828 to S. Kaleopaa to an iron spike;
4. 106° 04' 614.68 feet along Lot 112 to an iron spike;
5. 196° 04' 150.00 feet along the East side of a road reservation to the point of beginning.
